


STAGE PLAN / TECH RIDER 2025

*The COPOLICE all use In Ear Monitors - IEM connections in **BLUE** below. All equipment listed below supplied by the COPOLICE

Drums:

- 1. 22" Bass Drum
- 2. 14" Snare Drum
- 3. 6" Octoban (mic from underneath please)
- 4. 10" Rack Tom
- 5. 12" Rack Tom
- 6. 16" Floor Tom
- 7. 14" Hi Hats
- 8. 22" Ride Cymbal
- 9. 8" Splash Cymbal
- 10. 17" Crash Cymbal
- 11. 6" Splash Cymbal
- 12. 18" Crash Cymbal
- 13. 16" Crash Cymbal

14. BBeat (backing track playback device) 2 x mono Jack outputs to FOH (mix in stereo please) and 1 mono Jack input for Rick's IEM mix. (Rick has vol control of internal click). and internal backing volume

15. Sennheiser wireless IEM transmitter No connections needed- sorted by Rick via the 'BBeat'.

16. Porter & Davies butt kicker - can accept feed from FOH/MON Engineer or can be self sufficient.

Guitar:

17. Guitar amp - either BadCat head and 1x12 cab or Mesa Boogie 1x12. Mic'd with SM57 or similar please.

Also happy with a supplied amp that is low-wattage valve.

18. Guitar pedalboard - No connections needed via FOH

19. IEM headphone amp. Monitor feed for Stef'sIEM routed here via Jack or XLR (wired IEMs)20. Stef vocal mic - EV ND96

Bass:

21. Aguilar tone hammer 350 bass amp (happy to use any supplied bass amp) - XLR out to **IEMs ONLY**

22. Bass pedalboard - XLR output from Sansamp pedal to FOH ONLY23. Riko (lead) vocal mic - SM58 beta

Riko uses an XVive wireless IEM pack. Transmitter from FOH/MON engineer is an XLR connection.
